Its objective is to prepare the student to apply scientific and technical knowledge in the resolution of problems related to processes of this nature in institutions, government and power.

1. Admission Application Form duly completed.
2. Official High School Certificate, original, issued by the Ministry of Education.
3. High School transcript in original.
4. Birth Certificate certified and in original. 5. Medical certificate.
6. Copy of identity and electoral card.
7. Photos 2 X 2.
8. Application for the Test of Orientation and Academic Measurement (POMA).
9. For students transferring from another institution, they must also present the transcript of grades from the institution of origin, duly legalized by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology (MESCyT).
